

CHAPTER MEMBERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

The Board of Central West Coast Chapter of Florida Public Relations Association recognizes that in certain economic climates, membership dues can be an obstacle for some chapter members, especially those self-employed and those who do not have the financial support of their employers. The purpose of this program is to help members remain enrolled and involved with our chapter and organization by offering scholarships to help in paying annual membership dues.

The issuance of scholarships should be considered annually by each new board, based on the health of the chapter's treasury and the apparent need in the membership.

SCHOLARSHIP LEVELS

There will be two levels of membership scholarships:

Full—in which the full cost of annual membership is granted on a one-time basis.

Partial—in which a portion of the membership is granted, and can be repeated up to three times. The portion can vary depending on dollars available and need.

The number of available scholarships will be determined by a committee consisting of the chapter President, Treasurer and the Sponsorship (Scholarship) chair. Applications will be reviewed by the entire Board and a 2/3rds majority vote will be required to grant a scholarship.

Scholarship qualifications will include previous membership, past service to the chapter, level of participation in chapter projects and events, and statement of need.
